The GFWC/CT Board Meeting on July 17,2021 was convened at 9:00 am at the Courtyard by Marriott in Waterbury, Ct.

President Debbie Fiore, whose motto is "We Rise by Lifting Others", called the meeting to order. Carolyn DellaPietra inspired the 53 members present with a reading that began – "There is no force more powerful than a woman determined to rise". A Memorial Service was held to remember our sisters who have passed since our last memorial service in 2019. Included were three members from the Windsor Woman's Club:

Christina Wilson – long-time member who had held many positions in the Windsor Woman's Club and in GFWC/CT

The proposed Budget for 2021 – 2022 was passed and dues remain the same - \$20 per member. \$5 to remain with GFWC/CT and \$15 to go to International GFWC.

Guest Speaker Jennifer DeWitt, Prevention Coordinator for Waterbury Department of Public Health, urged members to become Mental Health First Aid providers. The function of these people is to provide an emotional connection while physically distancing. "I understand you are facing issues. I do not know how you feel. I have faced similar issues and this is what helped me..." Then referring the individual to relevant resources. This is important because more than 50% of Americans will be diagnosed with a mental illness or disorder. The most common of which are anxiety and depression. Jennifer noted that in Waterbury, since the inception of the program in 2019, there has been a 30% drop in the suicide rate in that city. She also noted that beginning is January Connecticut will have a

988 Suicide Prevention Hotline. Similar to the 911 Emergency Hotline. The Awards normally presented at District Days and May Convention were distributed. Windsor Woman's Club received:

1st place for medium sized club for Communications and Public Relations

1st place for Health and Wellness for the North Central District





Kathleen DeBurra received the Jenny Award. This is the only individual award given for outstanding service.
