One of GFWC International President Mary Ellen Brock's (2018-2020) Grand Initiatives during her tenure is to host a Shoe Drive in clubs around the country. . The goal of this initiative is to donate 40,000 pairs of **Gently Worn** shoes to Soles4Souls and Nike Reuse-ashoe program. To date, 36, 763 pairs of shoes have been donated.

The WWC Board has recommended we host a Shoe Drive at the February meeting. Please bring any **Gently Used** shoes that you no longer want to our February meeting. Shoes should be bound together with a rubber band or tied together with ribbon or string. There will be a collection bin at the meeting for the shoes.

The shoes you no longer want can create jobs for people in developing countries. Just one pair of used shoes could provide five meals in Haiti.
